## 8. Arrival

**By plane:** Fly to Vienna International Airport. <http://www.viennaairport.com>  
There are direct flights from the most capital cities across the World.

### **From Vienna international airport to the Event-location:**

- Take the **CAT** (City Airport Train) to station “**Landstraße/Wien Mitte**”
- From “**Landstraße/Wien Mitte**” take the metro **U4** (direction „Heiligenstadt“) for just one station to „**Schwedenplatz**“
- From „**Schwedenplatz**“ take the metro **U1** (direction “Leopoldau”) to the Station “**Kagran**”.
- From “**Kagran**” take the tramway 26 to Station “**Polgarstraße**”. There you will see the Climbing Gym Vienna on right hand side. **WELCOME!**

**By road:** Take the highways A1 (lead from Salzburg), A2 (lead from Graz) or A4 (lead from Budapest) to Vienna.

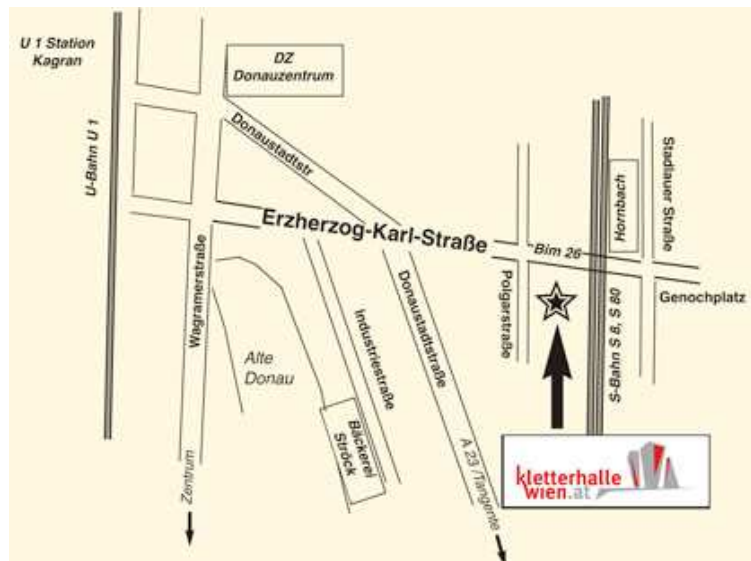
**By rail:** All international trains stop at Vienna.

It depends on which train stop you arrive in Vienna, but look for the Metro U1 and then

- take the metro **U1** (direction “Leopoldau”) to the station “**Kagran**”.
- From “**Kagran**” take the tramway 26 to station “**Polgarstraße**”. There you will see the Climbing Gym Vienna on right hand side. **WELCOME!**
